The club will provide free appetizers and you have to purchase your own drinks. Plan on attending, Its important and fun.



After a few unusually warm days I realized that I had best hurry if I wanted to get any Winter car projects finished. Well first I would have to start them and then try to complete them. Luckily my TR8 was running great last Summer and whenever I have used it for local errands it has started right up and run fine. There are a few cosmetic issues like the ratty carpets and paint work that looked amazing 20 years ago when it was fresh starting to show its share of nicks and scrapes. I don't plan to work on either of these this year.

So what did I plan to get accomplished? Well I have been thinking about trying to improve my visibility to other drivers. Years back I upgraded the head light bulbs to halogen sealed beams and they seem reasonably bright. I bought bulb sockets for the tail and brake lights that took double filament bulbs and doubled my lighting out back. I also added a high mount brake light long ago. I swapped the instrument lights and courtesy light to LEDs. But now maybe I will swap the side markers to LEDs and see if that makes things brighter. And I have been considering some daytime running lights up front.

I looked at daytime running lights at the local parts places and they only cost about \$25 which is cheap if they save you a head on collision. Then I looked online and found what looks like

the same thing for less than a ten spot with free shipping. Finding a place to mount those will be my challenge. They need to stand out prominently when they are on. But it would be nice if they sort of disappeared when I was showing the car. Not quite sure I can manage both. And if I don't get started soon this hour long job won't get done before the crabgrass needs mowing.





Club History

As late as 1970, despite a long and prestigious history of automobile production dating to 1923, and a corporate history reaching back to the 1880's, there was no American organization dedicated to the history, preservation, and enjoyment of Triumph automobiles. Aware that a large percentage of Triumphs built since World War II had been sold in the USA and Canada, a dedicated group of Triumph owners, enthusiasts, and historians in 1973 planted the early seeds of what would become the Vintage Triumph Register. In 1974 the organization began to take shape, and by January, 1975, the club's first professionally edited and printed magazine appeared. At last there was a club for all Triumph owners; and growth of the club since has been steady, with more than 2,600 members!

Milestones along the way have included:

- adoption of color covers on *The Vintage Triumph* (http://vintagetriumphregister.org/tvt/)
- · reprinting of valuable Triumph manuals
- efforts to save obsolete Triumph spares from destruction
- a concerted effort to encourage quality reproduction of needed spares
- the establishment of a VTR archival collection
- $\circ~$ the introduction of VTR judging standards
- the creation of a discount Triumph book service
- absorption of the Triumph Sports Owners Association (TSOA), the factory-sponsored owners' club for 26 years from 1955 to 1981.

An important annual event is the VTR Convention. Called the North American Triumph Challenge, it is held in a different state each year. Every convention includes a fun-filled activity schedule with rallies, autocross, a judged concours d'elegance and participant's choice car show, autojumble, parts vendor sales, and much, much more. VTR's national gatherings are always exciting, rewarding and over the years have introduced many, many Triumph owners to one another and produced fond memories. We hope you'll join VTR and one of our over 70 local VTR Chapters, as we pursue a bright and promising future for the ownership, operation, and preservation of Triumph automobiles.
