

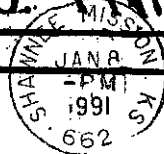

THE JANUARY 1981 NEWSLETTER ANNOUNCED PLANS FOR MATRI (MID-AMERICA TRIUMPH REGIONAL) TO BE HELD IN JUNE. THIS WAS THE FORERUNNER OF THE ALL BRITISH MEET. RICK TORRES WAS VERY ACTIVE, SPONSORING A TECH SESSION AT HIS NEW SHOP FOR JANUARY, AND A PARTY AT HIS HOUSE (THE OLD BASEMENT PARTY ROOM) IN FEBRUARY. MARLIN & PAT COOPER WERE WELCOMED AS NEW MEMBERS OF K.C.T.

AS I LOOK OUTSIDE AT A DECIDEDLY WINTER LANDSCAPE I THINK IT MIGHT BE APPROPRIATE, AND YOU MIGHT ENJOY, AND I CAN "PAD" THIS ARTICLE, BY REPRINTING A PIECE I WROTE FOR THE NEWSLETTER TEN YEARS AGO:

"A COLD WINTER NIGHT SOMEWHERE BETWEEN HONEY CREEK AND GREEN LAKE, WISCONSIN, A MEMORY OF FEELING, NOT FACT; A CURIOUS COMBINATION OF WARMTH, EXCITEMENT, ADVENTURE AND SECURITY. MY TWIN AND I WERE LYING IN THE BACK OF A '47 FORD - HE ON THE SEAT AND I ON THE FLOOR, WRAPPED IN OUR SNOWSUITS AND COVERED WITH BLANKETS. EVEN NOW I CAN FEEL THE DRUMMING OF THE TORQUE-TUBE, THE FEED BACK OF SPINNING TIRES THROUGH HENRY'S ARCHAIC SUSPENSION; AND THE SOUTH WIND HEATER'S TEPID BREEZE VIA SWINGING DOORS (A LA TR3). MOM AND DAD WERE IN FRONT PROBABLY ANXIOUS TO GET HOME, BUT I COULD HAVE GONE ON FOREVER. IT WAS A PERFECT FEELING.

THE LITTLE SPIT EVEN CAME TO LIFE THE NEXT MORNING. IT WAS A GREAT FEELING. THE MARRIAGE, BY THE WAY, WAS A GOOD ONE; LASTED NEARLY FIFTEEN YEARS, WHICH WAS LONGER THAN THE SPITFIRE.
