

KANSAS RIB RUN RALLY SEPTEMBER 16, 2023 - 8:00 AM - 2:00 PM

NO RALLY EXPERIENCE IS REQUIRED!

The Kansas Rib Run Rally, sponsored by the Kansas City Triumph Sports Car Club, is a fun Time-Speed-Distance (TSD) Rally on Saturday, September 16. SCCA Rallymasters Rich Bireta and Albert Weaver have laid out the route, which will be approximately 100 miles in length, traversing Leavenworth, Douglas, Shawnee and Jefferson Counties. The event chair is Jeff Givens, KC Triumphs. The entry fee is \$20 per car.

This event is open to ONLY classic British cars built before 1986. Early registration before September 1 will be limited to the following number of cars from each marque:

Triumph – 10 Cars

MG – 10 Cars

Austin Healey – 10 Cars

Jaguar & Other British – 8 Cars

Registration will be on a first paid basis, so sign up and pay early. If a marque is filled prior to September 1, late registrations for that marque will be waitlisted. If a marque is not filled by September 1, the waitlisted entries will be registered in the order payment is received up to an overall total of 38 cars. Please be advised there are NO refunds after August 31.

The Rally will be managed and scored using Richta Rally Apps' (<u>richtarally.com</u>) Competitor — Richta GPS Checkpoints App available free from your app store downloaded to your navigator's smartphone or tablet. Each entry will consist of a driver and a navigator who will receive written general instructions. Turn-by- turn instructions and speed information will automatically update on the navigator's smart phone or tablet via the app. Working speedometer, odometer, and writing materials are highly recommended. All vehicles registered will receive a dash plaque and awards will be given for first, second and third place.

The Rally will start from The Fuel House, 611 W 2nd St, Bonner Springs, KS 66012 which will offer a limited breakfast menu starting at 7:00 AM. Arrive by 8:00 AM for check-in and orientation. The first car will be off on the route at 9:01 AM. The Rally will end at the barbeque rib cookout hosted by Doug & Regina Schimke (Austin Healey Club) at 22165 171st Street, Basehor, Kansas 66007. All Rally participants and families are invited. Over 160 racks of ribs will be cooked, 20 pork butts, and 20 briskets, with all the trimmings offered; a meal fit for a King, or Classic British Car Rally participant! Water and soft drinks will be provided and you may bring your own adult beverages. Voluntary cash donations will be gladly accepted to help cover the Schimke's cost of the cookout.

In addition, Mr. Gary Gumminger (renowned and celebrated Kansas City British car mechanic) will be available for the Rally on a "just in case of breakdown" basis for a nominal cost per breakdown event. He will also bring some associated parts by marque. However, each car should carry some spares. In the highly unlikely event a "breakdown" cannot be immediately repaired, a truck and trailer will be available to haul the unfortunate "victim" to the barbeque, where Mr. Gumminger can provide more personal attention (while eating barbeque of course), and other members seriously "pontificate" on the reason for the untimely demise and "road rescue".
